



## 2020-21 Pee Dee Academy Home Basketball Game Policies

In order to play basketball this season during the COVID-19 Pandemic, we must make changes to our basketball gameday for the health & safety of all involved. In accordance with this reality, here are our policies for the upcoming HOME basketball season:

- On nights when both JV teams & both Varsity teams play, the JV Girls will begin @ 3:30.
- On nights when there are only 3 games played, we will begin @ 4:00.
- On nights when there are only 2 varsity games played, we will begin @ 6:00.
- All fans will be required to submit to a temperature check upon entering the gym. Fans are strongly encouraged to not attend games if they aren't feeling well or have had a fever in the last 24 hours.
- Fans will be required to wear a face covering the entire time they are in our gym.
- The concession stand will not be open to purchase any food or beverages and will be closed during games.
- **The gym will be completely cleared of fans and student-athletes between EVERY game of the night to allow for cleaning of the bleachers, scorer's table, team benches, and restrooms. A separate ticket will be required for entry to each game of the night.**
- Fans will not be permitted entrance into the gym until time for the game in which their ticket was purchased for. Example: A person with a JV Boys ticket is not permitted entrance until AFTER the gym has been cleared following the JV Girls game.
- Tickets to all home games must be purchased ahead of time through the PDA main office. Ticket allotment for each game will be as follows:
  - 3 tickets per home player & cheerleader
  - 2 tickets per visitor player (visiting teams will not bring cheerleaders)
  - PDA Booster Club passes & SCISA passes will be honored
- **For PDA parents/families:** There will be separate season tickets for each team: JV Girls, JV Boys, Varsity Girls, Varsity Boys, JV Cheer, Varsity Cheer. Each season ticket will cost \$20 and gain the ticket holder admittance to only the 1 game their child is involved in (exception: cheerleader parents 2 games). The ticket holder will be required to leave the gym after the designated game they paid for. There will be no general admission entrance.
  - **Example:** John Doe has a daughter playing JV Girls Basketball & a son playing varsity boys basketball. He may buy 3 JV Girls season tickets @ \$60 total and also must buy 3 Varsity Boys season tickets @ \$60 total. He must leave after the JV Girls game and not reenter until after the Varsity Girls game.
- **For visiting parents/families:** Schools will email a roster of all their basketball teams to Athletic Director Lon Spivey at least one week prior to the game. We will then mail the visiting school two total tickets per each player listed on the rosters. Visiting schools will collect money from their parents/families and mail one check to PDA to cover the total cost of tickets and will distribute tickets ahead of time to their fans attending the game.
